Bernard "Bernie" K. Lawrence, 89, of Petersburg, Illinois, passed away at his home on Monday, June 27, 2022. He was born March 20, 1933, in Springfield, Illinois, the son of Leonard and Mildred (Simpson) Lawrence. He married Mary "Brandy" Brady on August 17, 1957, in New York City.
