



Thomas E. Grosboll

March 7, 1942 - February 17, 2019

Thomas E. Grosboll, 76, of Petersburg, died on Sunday, February 17, 2019, at Memorial Medical Center. He was born on March 7, 1942 in Springfield to Thomas K. and Kathryn Kelly Grosboll. He married Nancy Tolan in 1973 and she survives. He is also survived by five children: Rachelle (Mike) Snopko of Washington, IL; Angela (John) Schilsky of Westlake, Texas; Natalie (Brian) Mitchell of Springfield, IL; Nathan (Jodi) Grosboll of Petersburg, IL, and Ryan Grosboll at home. Additionally, he is survived by ten grandchildren: Gavin, Reese and Toby Snopko; Caroline, Claire, and Kate Schilsky; Nadia and India Mitchell; and Aiden and Audrey Grosboll. His surviving siblings include Nancy Cobb of El Segundo, California; Cathie Smith of Petersburg; Connie Brauer of Cambria, California; John Grosboll of Petersburg; and Jan Costello of Petersburg. Several nieces, nephews and cousins also survive.

Tom (Tommy) graduated from Petersburg Harris High School in 1960 and also served in the Army National Guard for six years. He was a lifelong Menard County farmer who spent his entire life in the Sandridge precinct. He never tired of the many facets of agriculture. He was especially happy when his son Nathan became a part of the farming operation. Grain and livestock production were the mainstay of the operation until livestock production was replaced by the restoration of antique tractors. Father and son restored many antique tractors, some of which were featured on the cover of Green magazine, a John Deere collector publication.

Tommy was not only known for his love of farming, he was known for his colorful personality, his sense of humor, his outgoing nature, his quick wit, and his love of people, especially his family. His ten grandchildren will especially remember the joy he shared with them while picking and shucking sweet corn, or when giving them rides on the Razor, or allowing them to buy anything they wanted at the Dairy Queen and the Dollar General. They also will remember that his truck and his pockets were always filled with tic tacs, and he would often engage them in an original and unique tic tac game.

Per his wishes, his organs have been donated to the Gift of Hope, an agency that

coordinates organ and tissue donation and supports families of donors in the northern three-quarters of Illinois and northwest Indiana.

Visitation will be held on Thursday, February 21, from 4:00 to 7:00 p.m. at Hurley Funeral Home in Petersburg. A funeral service will be held on Friday, February 22 at 10:00 a.m. at Central Presbyterian Church in Petersburg with burial to follow at Oakland Cemetery. Pastor Diane Ludington will be officiating the services.

In lieu of flowers, memorials are suggested to the Petersburg Rural Fire Department or the Menard County Food Pantry.
