



## Aldyth L. Long

August 27, 1916 - March 10, 2009

Aldyth L. Long, 92, died Tuesday March 10th, at Heritage Manor, in Beardstown.

Mrs. Long was born August 27th 1916 in Oakford, IL, the daughter of Orlan and Edith Lynn. She graduated from Springfield, High School, in 1934, and entered Nurses Training. She married Edward Long on February 17, 1937, in Springfield. A mother, homemaker and wife also actively involved in the Springfield Art Association, Symphony Guild, Beaux Arts Ball, Jr. League and member of Illini Country Club.
