May 5, 1931 - February 19, 2013

Alfred L. White, 81, of Petersburg, passed away peacefully on Tuesday, February 19, 2013 at Memorial Medical Center in Springfield. He was born May 5, 1931 in Phoenix, IL, the son of Raymond and Nellie (South) White. Al married Carol Schmidt in Hazel Crest, IL on September 14, 1957.
