Amy Housworth Hedstrom, a Lady of elegant tastes, never ending friendships and continuous grace, passed away on June 21, 2008 at 3:19am, at the Memorial Medical Center in Springfield . She was born December 9, 1925, the daughter of Dr. Fred G. and Elsie (Warren) Housworth in Mason City . She married C.N. "Saul" Hedstrom on June 20, 1953 in Mason City ; he died July 11, 2003.

Survivors are one son: Josh Warren Hedstrom of Springfield ; four nieces and one nephew. Mrs. Hedstrom is preceded in death by four sisters, LaVerne Biggs, Mary Leda Wagner and twin infant sisters.

Mrs. Hedstrom was a member of the United Presbyterian Church in Mason City , a graduate of Mason City High School , and a graduate from nursing school.
