Anna Marie Meyer, 90, of Manito, Illinois, passed away peacefully at 6:09 p.m. on Wednesday, July 10, 2024 at the Lodge in Manito. Born on January 25, 1934 in Pekin, Illinois to Henry and Irene (Galvin) Osterman, Anna, known affectionately as "Grannie Annie" to her beloved family and as Ann to her many friends, was a beacon of love, faith, and warmth to all who knew her. On January 30, 1960, Anna married the love of her life, Deacon William E. Meyer, embarking on a beautiful journey that would span over six decades. Together, they built a loving family and a home filled with laughter, faith, and the irresistible aroma of freshly baked cookies. Grannie Annie's love knew no bounds. She is survived by her devoted husband, Deacon William E. In her younger years, Anna was quite the athlete, playing softball for the Pekin Lettes and Dairyettes. She brought the same passion and dedication to her sports as she did to every aspect of her life. Anna was preceded in death by her parents, sisters Katie Wiebler and Sherry Roberts, and brothers Jimmy, Terry, and Bud Osterman. While they are no longer with us, their memories lived on in the stories she loved to share with her family. 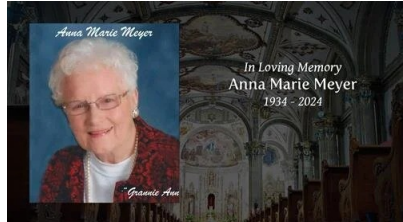
