Anne Elizabeth Cunningham, 77, of Springfield, formerly of Havana, passed away at The Christian Village in Lincoln, at 3:54 p.m. on Thursday, January 16, 2020. She was born December 15, 1942, in Jerseyville, Illinois, to Hugh B. and Fae (England) Cunningham.

Ms. Cunningham is survived by two brothers: Michael “Mick” (Sue) Cunningham of Easton, David Cunningham, of Fremont, California; two nephews, one niece, three great-nieces and one great-nephew. She was preceded in death by her parents and her beloved dog Charlie Brown.

Ms. Cunningham was of the Catholic faith. She was involved in organizing her graduating class activities. She had also been active in the LaPlaza Grande Condo Association in Springfield, serving as President for several years. 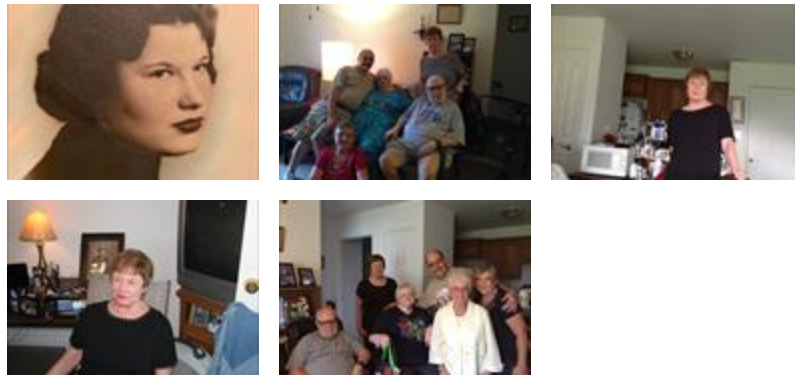
