Anthony J. "Tony" Doll Jr, 65, of Lincoln, passed away at his home on Wednesday, February 28, 2018. Tony was born November 28, 1952 in LaSalle-Peru, IL; the son of the late Anthony and Fabiana "Fay" (Glubczynski) Doll Sr. Tony married Teresa McLaughlin in Las Vegas on November 11, 1990. For a few years Tony worked as the owner and operator of the Dew Drop Inn located in LaSalle, IL; and later owned and operated the A&W Family Restaurant in Lincoln Illinois for 28 years until he retired. Outside of work Tony enjoyed collecting cars, and rescuing cats. In his earlier years Tony enjoyed practicing Tae Kwan Do. Tony had been a very active member and volunteer with the American Red Cross; helping with many National Disaster Relief efforts all over the country. He served 2 years with Americorps serving his term with the American Red Cross Central Illinois Chapter located in Springfield Illinois. He helped with clean-up efforts after some of the local tornadoes. He also had been a volunteer with the Abraham Lincoln Presidential Museum and Library as well as other charitable organizations. Tony was raised in the Catholic faith, after moving to Lincoln he joined the Lincoln Christian Church.

Surviving Tony is his wife Teresa of Lincoln, his daughter Morgan (Aaron) Beck of Sherman, IL, his granddaughters Alivia and Emelia Beck, his sisters; Mary Ann (John) Liles of Tonica, IL, Carol (Michael) Jones of St. Peters, MO, Sharon (James) Bacidore of LaSalle, IL, as well as 8 nieces, 9 nephews, 5 great-nieces, 16 great-nephews, 4 great-great-nieces and 2 great great

nephews.

Tony was preceded in death by his sister Dorothy (Carmen) Santucci, his uncles: Aloysius "Al", Edmund "Eddie" and Florian Glubczynski, nephews Nicholas "Nick" Santucci, and James Bacidore Jr, great-niece Jennifer Eutis, and beloved father-in-law, Kenneth McLaughlin.
