Barbara Warner Patton, 81, formerly of Homosassa, Florida, passed away Dec. 20, 2018, at Heritage Manor hospice care in Springfield, Illinois. Barbara was born May 31, 1937, in Houston, Texas, the daughter of Wilmot Francis and Lenore (Anderson) Warner. She was married first to Arthur F.
