



Rev. Billy D. Sexton

June 1, 1928 - June 19, 2014

Rev. Billy D. Sexton, Sr., 86, of Tallula, formerly of Petersburg, passed away on Thursday, June 19, 2014 at Memorial Medical Center. He was born June 1, 1928 in Springfield, the son of William Henry and Ardena Pauline (Turley) Sexton. Billy married Vada Belle Van Boggelen on August 24, 1951 in Grand Haven, MI. She preceded him in death on February 8, 2004.

He is survived by his children DeeAnn (Rev. Duane) Cross of Weston, MI; Billy Dean (Mihaela) Sexton, Jr. of Petersburg; Deborah (Malcom) Scott of Dallas, TX; four grandchildren and a sister Jacqueline Good of Belleville, IL.
