Bobby Rogers Sr., 82, of Green Valley passed away Saturday afternoon March 30, 2019 in Montrose, Iowa. He was born August 11, 1936 in Cherokee, Alabama the son of Arthur and Rebecca Moody Rogers. He married Joeann Tisdale on July 12, 1959 in Forest City, Illinois and she preceded him in death on January 28, 2011. His parents, two brothers John Rogers and Charles Rogers, and one special friend Joyce Zevnik also preceded him in death. He is survived by one son, Bobby (Becky) Rogers Jr. of Green Valley; three daughters, Deborah (Rob) Crumrine, and Danita (Rich) King both of Killen, Alabama, and Dawn Rogers of Green Valley, Illinois. One brother Clifford (Betty) Rogers of Guntersville, Alabama also survives. He has 16 grandchildren and 19 ½ great grandchildren. Bobby grew up in Cherokee, Alabama and graduated high school in 1955. He moved to Manito, Illinois where he met the love of his life Joeann Tisdale. He worked at Atwood In Havana, Illinois which was bought by Victor Dana and later transferred to Chicago to work for Dana Corp. in 1980. He retired from Dana in 1986 and returned to Pekin, Illinois and worked at E.M. Smith in Peoria. In 1995 he opened his own business with his son Bobby Jr. (Midwest Precision Machining) in Pekin. He fully retired in 2000 and moved to Green Valley and lived there since.

Bobby enjoyed woodworking, gospel music, and sports, sports, sports. He loved his St. Louis Cardinals, Chicago Bears, and Alabama Football "Roll Tide." He attended the Forest City Community Church for many years where

he taught Sunday School and was Sunday School Superintendent.

Funeral services for Bobby will be 10 A.M. Friday, April 5, 2019 at the Maas-Hurley Funeral Home in Manito. Pastor Albert Abels will officiate. Internment will follow at Green Valley Cemetery. 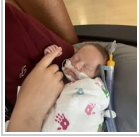
