Carl H. Knous, 86 of Petersburg passed away on Monday, February 11, 2013, at Sunny Acres Home. He was born in Alexander, IL on March 29, 1926 to J.W. and Margaret (Hermes) Knous. Carl married Carole Hubbartt on July 3, 1954. She survives.

Volunteer Fireman for 29 years, Lake Petersburg Board, Ducks Unlimited, and was a member of St. Peter Catholic Church.
