Carole Helen Heubner of Petersburg passed away peacefully on September 18, 2017 at Memorial Medical Center. Born to the late Floyd and Eileen (Tieken) Forrest on September 5, 1935, Carole was a graduate of Mendon Unity High School in Mendon, Illinois. She married James Heubner on the date of her eighteenth birthday, September 5, 1953 in Columbus, Illinois. As a young couple, Carole and Jim made their home in several small communities including Quincy, Coatsburg, Leroy, Monticello, and Pittsfield before finally settling in Petersburg. She had five great-grandchildren, Brooke and Kyle Heubner of Sherman, Mason and Regan Heubner of Petersburg, and Nora Heubner of Springfield. She is also survived by one brother, Terry (Donna) Forrest of Quincy, Illinois, two brothers-in-law, Ron Heubner of Scottsdale, Arizona, James Wellman of Fort Wayne, Indiana, and several nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by a sister-in-law, Sandra Wellman.
