



Charles David "Chuck" Herrman

December 6, 1946 - February 3, 2019

Charles David "Chuck" Herrman, age 72, passed away at 3:00 AM on Sunday, February 3, 2019 at his home in Manito.

He was born to Elmer and Mildred (Finley) Herrman on December 6, 1946 in Pekin. He married Judy Thomas on April 27, 1968 in Manito.

Chuck is survived by his wife Judy of Manito; children, Douglas (Brandi) Herrman, Josh (Leah) Herrman, and Adam Herrman, all of Manito; and grandchildren, Blake, Corey, Ethan, Lucas, Elsie, Isaac, and Calvin, all of Manito.

He was preceded in death by his parents.

Chuck was a Vietnam Era veteran and served in the National Guard in Delevan, was involved with the Forman Fire Department, and was a member of both the Tazewell County Farm Bureau and the National Street Rod Association. He collected 50-60's Fords and loved spending time with his grandchildren.

Chuck began farming in 1986 in Spring Lake Township near Manito and owned and operated Herrman Autobody for 50 years.

Cremation rites have been accorded and a memorial service for Chuck will be held at his church, Spring Lake Missionary Church, on Saturday, February 9, 2019 at 10:30 AM. Pastor Tom Schakat will officiate. A visitation will be held one hour prior to the service time at the church, and also from 4:00-7:00 PM on Friday, February 8, 2019 at the church.
