Charles A. Prince, 81, of Havana, passed away at Havana Healthcare at 8:36 a.m. on Thursday, September 13, 2012. He was born February 17, 1931 in Havana to Orin W. and Verna (Boesch) Prince. He married Barbara Rich, January 8, 1967 in Normal, IL.

Mr. Prince is survived by his wife Barbara, daughter Catharine (Harold) Reavley and granddaughter Sophia Reavley, all of Havana. Also surviving are two sisters, Edna Kastendick and Emily F.
