Charlotte Kincaid, 80, of Petersburg, Illinois, passed away Wednesday, December 13, 2023, at Sunny Acres Nursing Home in Petersburg. She was born September 1, 1943, in Petersburg, to Carl and Pauline (McLaughlin) Atterberry. She married Victor Kincaid on January 12, 1963, at the First Baptist Church in Petersburg.
