



Clifford R. Sorensen

December 25, 1921 - January 5, 2008

Clifford R. Sorensen, 86, of Havana, passed away at his home at 4:46 p.m. on Saturday, January 5, 2008. He was born December 25, 1921 in Cassion, WI to Soren and Ada (Thyburg) Sorensen. On July 30, 1944 he married Doris Cvercek in Riverside, CA.

Mr. Sorensen is survived by his wife, Doris, of Havana, two daughters: Carol (Robert LaFollette of Fairmont, WV and Mary Ellen Simpson of Havana, three grandsons: Jean-Paul LaFollette, Robert Clifford LaFollette and Brian Sorensen, two granddaughters: Aimee LaFollette and Andrea Mineo, six great-grandchildren: Taylor Mineo, Austin Curtis Sorensen, Emma Margaret Sorensen, Madeline LaFollette, Claudia Lafollette and Michael Wilson. He was preceded in death by his parents and five brothers and sisters, and one grandson, Curtis Simpson.

Mr. Sorensen was a member of the Havana United Methodist Church, the Izaak Walton League, the American Foundryman Association, the Reserve Officer's Association and the Havana Rotary Club where he was awarded the Paul Harris Fellow Medal. He served in the Air Force from 1942 until 1978, retiring with the rank of Colonel. After retirement, he received an offer from the Air Force to attend War College in Washington D.C. and become a Brigadier General. He attended college at the University of Wisconsin – Madison and IIT in Chicago, achieving a degree in Metallurgy. When he moved to Havana,

he designed and built the Atwood Foundry.

Cremation rites have been accorded and a private service will be held at a later date.
