July 12, 1915 - November 10, 2007

Clifton Phillips, 92, of Havana, died at Mason District Hospital in Havana at 12:10 p.m. on Saturday, November 10, 2007. He was born July 12, 1915 in Lebanon, MO to Russell and Susan Phillips. He married Dorothy Anglen on January 1, 1939 in Lebanon.

Mr. Phillips is survived by his wife Dorothy of Havana, four children: Ronald (Marlene) Phillips, Linda Phillips and Carl Phillips all of Havana and Glenda (Merle) Long of Lacon, IL.
