Clint Steven Miller, 56, passed away on Monday, May 17, 2021 in Buffalo, IL surrounded by loving family. He was born February 4, 1965 to James S. and Patricia A. (Tibbs) Miller. Clint is survived by his wife Rebecca (Lirui Du) Miller; his two children, Veronica (11 yrs old) and Victor (6 yrs old) Miller; his mother, Patricia (Allan Frazier) Miller of Ashmore, IL; brother, Bruce (Tasha) Miller of Naperville, IL; and sister, Shannon (Mark) Whalen of Mechanicsburg, IL.
