



Clinton "Doc" Boyer

April 25, 1934 - June 6, 2007

Clinton "Doc" Boyer, 73, of Bath, IL died at his home at 7:36 a.m. on Wednesday, June 6, 2007. He was born April 25, 1934 in Ellsinore, MO, the son of Charles P. and Oma (Jett) Boyer. He married Deloris Ann Richardson on December 26, 1956 in Chandlerville, IL; she survives.

Clinton served in the U.S. Army from December 1956 through December 1958.

He was an automotive repairman at several garages around Havana including Weaver Motors and B & B Motors. He worked for International Harvester in Canton, IL from September 1966 until he was laid off in 1982. He began working for Navistar in Springfield, OH in 1988 and retired from the Urbana,

OH plant in April 1994.

Clinton was a member of the AF & AM Lodge #88 for 32 years. He was of the Baptist faith and most recently attended Bethel Baptist Mission Church in Bath, IL.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, June 9, 2007 at 11:00 a.m. at the Hurley Funeral Home in Havana. Visitation will be held Friday evening from 5 – 7 p.m. also at the funeral home. Burial will follow the services at Bath Cemetery. Rev. Vince French will officiate.
