



Clyde Leroy Shoemaker

Clyde Leroy Shoemaker, 91, of Chandlerville, passed away at Memorial Medical Center, in Springfield, at 2:11 p.m. on Thursday, October 26, 2017. He was born December 17, 1925 in Mason County, Illinois, to Orville Nelson and Maizie Mae (Richards) Shoemaker. He married Helen Louetta Richard on October 30, 1948 in Virginia, Illinois.

Mr. Shoemaker is survived by his wife, Helen, of Chandlerville and one daughter, Lori Ann (Glenn) Moss of Atterberry, IL, as well as many nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, great-great-nieces, great-great-nephews, great-great-great nieces and great-great-great-nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents, two sisters: Marjorie Mae Helton and Roberta Smith and one brother: Floyd Leonard Shoemaker.

Mr. Shoemaker was a member of the Virginia Christian Church and also frequently attended Bethel Baptist Church. He was a member of Lodge #724 in Chandlerville. He served in the US Army during WWII, in Italy. He enjoyed riding motorcycles, piloting airplanes, traveling and camping, as well as wintering in Florida. He worked as a school teacher for nine years, first at a local country school and later in the Ashland school district. Later, he worked for CIPS for over thirty years, retiring in 1988.
