Dale D. Funkenbusch, 92, of Havana passed away peacefully Monday morning, August 8, 2022 at St. John's Hospital in Springfield.

Dale was born December 17, 1929, the son of Arch and Florence (Neikamp) Funkenbusch of Palmyra, MO. He graduated from Palmyra High School and was a graduate of the University of Missouri School of Agriculture.

Dale married Dorothy Ann Archer in Hannibal, MO, seventy years ago on February 3, 1952. She survives.

He was employed in the Agriculture field all his career.

Dale was preceded in death by his parents, brothers, Roger and Don, and sister, Shirley Rathbun.

Along with his wife, Ann, he is survived by children; David (Chaem), Philip, Lisa Hellman (Robert), and Marty Lane (Rick), as well as many grandchildren, great-grandchildren, nieces, and nephews.

“ I met Dale in 1954 when as a 10-yearold boy I was trying to earn money to go to Boy Scout Camp in Osceola, Missouri. Dale was in charge of the crews of mostly teenagers who de-tasseled hybrid corn for Pfister Associated Growers in Carrollton, MO. As I recall, Dale lived on North Main Street not far from my home and I walked to his house and just knocked on his door. He came to the door and after I stated my business, he asked me how old I was! This was a dreaded question as I might have been too young for this very arduous work. Dale treated me with respect and in a very professional manner and he asked if my parents knew about my "application" for employment. I told him yes and that my dad would give me a ride to the town square where the workers loaded into the back of a truck and were taken to the corn fields south of town. I forget the details, but Dale did in fact hire me and I was assigned to a crew of mostly boys who were a couple of years older. I worked that job for three summers and at a then very attractive labor rate of about 50 cents per hour. I saved my money and attended Scout camp for four years. I was so proud to have this job and remember my dad telling me to offer to shake hands and say "Thank You" to Dale following my first payday. Dale was a kind, soft-spoken man that gave me a great start in my working life. Thank You Dale!
