



## Dallas "Bud" Burgett

March 21, 1938 - July 31, 2024

Dallas "Bud" Burgett, 86, of Havana, passed away at his home at 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, July 31, 2024. He was born on March 21, 1938 in Havana to Chester and Margaret (Smith) Burgett. He married Rosemary Bridges on May 19, 1957 in Havana, and she survives.

Bud is also survived by his children, Debbie (Chris) Bishop of Havana, DeEtta (Carl) Martorana of South Gulf Cove, Florida, and David (April) Burgett of Astoria; grandchildren, Erica (Ray) Braden and Savannah and Anabelle Burgett; great-grandson, Hank Braden; brother, Chester L. 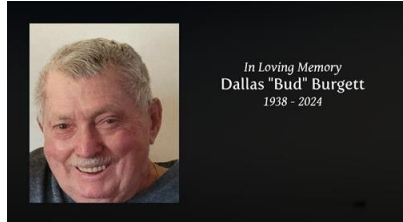
