Darlene D. Robertson, 88 of New Holland, died at 1:45am, Sunday, April 12, 2009 at her residence. She was born August 15, 1920 the daughter of Robert and Helen (Hull) Ford in Mason City. She married James T. Robertson on December 24, 1937 in Palmira MO; he died July 9, 1970.

Survivors are one son: James Robertson of Swan Valley, MT; one brother: Robert Ford of Bouse AZ; two grandchildren and two great-grandchildren. She is preceded in death by two sisters.

Mrs. Robertson was a member of the Christian Church in Mason City. She started her career working in the Café business for her grandfather, Alonzo Hull, located on the corner of Chestnut and Tonica, when she was a teenager. She owned and operated Robertson Café from 1953-1970, then back to where Chestnut Street Grill is at from 1970-1989. In 1989 she went to New Holland and worked at the New Holland Bar and Grill where Ron Douglas, the owner said her specialty was fried chicken, coconut crème and banana crème pie. She will be deeply missed.
