



Darrel Wayne Bacon

March 5, 1960 - February 6, 2018

Darrel Wayne Bacon of Petersburg, passed away Tuesday, February 6th, 2018 after a hard-fought battle with kidney and prostate cancer. Darrel was born on March 5, 1960 in Springfield; the son of Roy and Nancy (Moore) Bacon.

Darrel retired from the United States Navy after 29 years (10 active, 19 reserve) as a Chief Petty Officer. He was an active member of the Salisbury Christian church and was attending Lincoln Christian University to pursue a degree in Bible Studies. Darrel was a lifetime member of the Boy Scouts of America serving as a scout master for many years.

Darrel was preceded into the arms of the Lord by his father, Roy Bacon; his sister Margie; and his niece Julie.

Darrel is survived by his three children: Katie, Tim, and Chris, as well as the mother of his children, Debi Bacon; his mother, Nancy Bacon; his sister Brenda Carper and brother-in-law Ed Carper, as well as many nieces, nephews, aunts, uncles, and cousins.

A funeral service officiated by Rev. Nathaniel Kern will be held at Salisbury Christian Church in Salisbury on Friday, February 9, 2018 at 11 am. The family will receive guests at the church from 9 am until the time of service.

Burial will take place at Farmers Point Cemetery in Tallula where military honors will be accorded by the Menard County Interveterans Ceremony Unit.

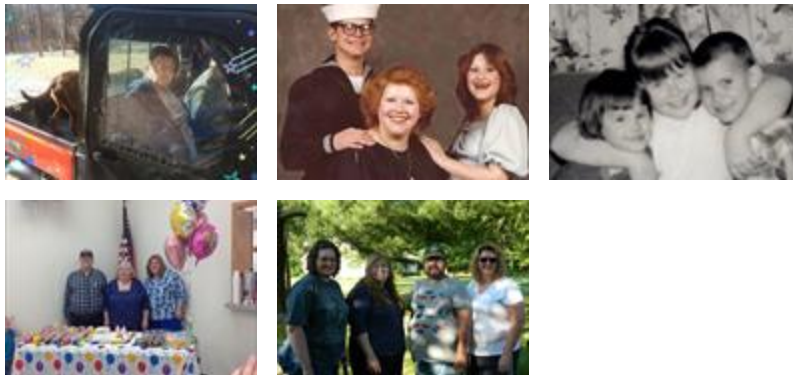
