Darrel "Bucky" Hunt, 79, of Chandlerville, died peacefully surrounded by his family on Sunday, October 4, 2015 at St. John's Hospice in Springfield, IL. Bucky was born in Chandlerville on February 25, 1936, to Homer "Dutch" and Alice Murphy Hunt. He was a lifelong resident of Chandlerville and spent the last 40 years living within a mile of his birthplace. In 1960, he married Kae Hampton, and they were married for 51 years until her death in 2011. Bucky is survived by son Stacy Hunt of Tucson, AZ and daughter Jodi Morgan of Petersburg; grandsons Dakota and Dillion Hunt and Luke and Nic Morgan and several nieces and nephews.

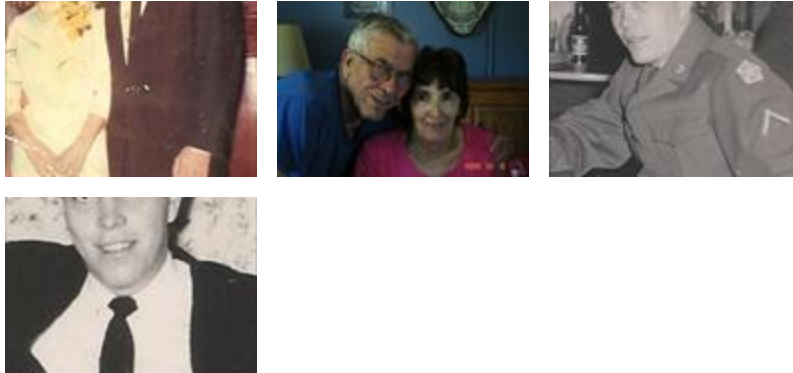

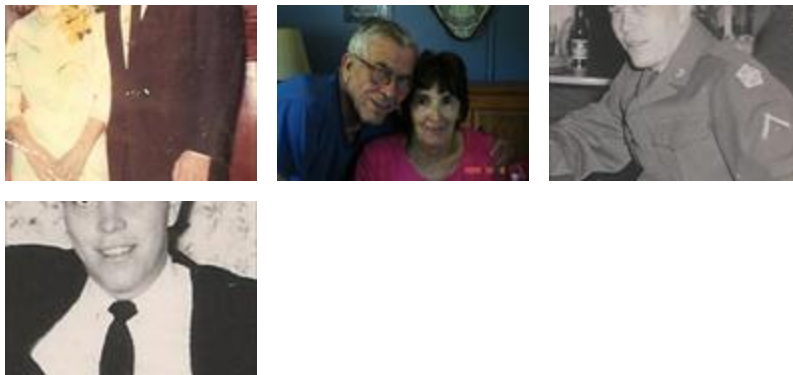
