



Rev. Dean C. Wright

May 15, 1930 - April 20, 2015

Rev. Dean C. Wright, 84, of Bath, passed away at his home at 10:07 a.m. on Monday, April 20, 2015. He was born May 15, 1930 in Rural Smithfield, IL to Ira and Gladys (Lovell) Wright. He married Eunice Glore on February 14, 1951 and she preceded him in death on March 7, 1990. He married Barbara Lanckton on June 27, 1992 and she survives.

Rev. Wright is survived by his wife, Barbara of Bath, five children, Rev. 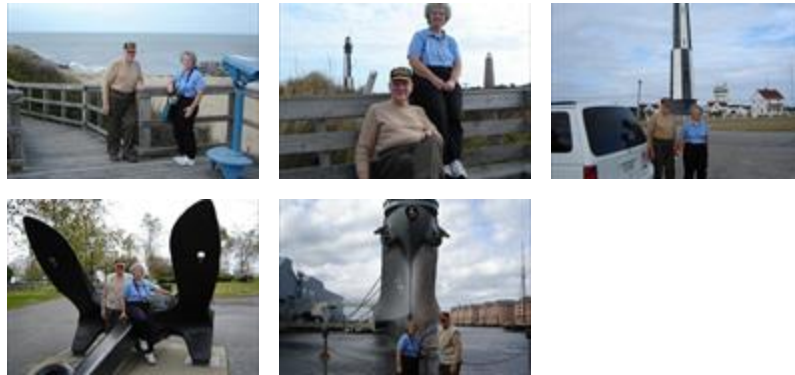
