Delbert O. Clayton, 93, of Havana passed away on Friday, June 3, 2022 at Sunny Acres Nursing Home in Petersburg. He was born on March 11, 1929 in Bluff City, Illinois in Schuyler County to LeRoy and Mary (Crable) Clayton. He married Deloras "Dorey" Ray on September 9, 1956. She preceded him in death on April 2, 2011.

Delbert is survived by his daughter, Lori (Dennis) Morgan of Havana and son, Logan (Liz) Clayton of Auburn, Illinois. He adored his three grandchildren, Megan (Matt) Livermore of Mapleton, Chase Morgan of Chicago, and Alec (Amy) Clayton of Auburn and five great-grandchildren.
