Donald H. Specketer, 85, of Havana, passed away at his home at 1:50 a.m. on Wednesday, September 07, 2011. He was born December 4, 1925 in rural Havana to Harry and Eleanor (Schilling) Specketer. He married Mildred White on June 5, 1946 in Havana.

Mr. Specketer is survived by his wife, Mildred, of Havana, son, Stephen (Barb) Specketer and daughter, Janice (Craig) Stephens, both of Havana, six grandchildren, twelve great-grandchildren, one brother, Kenneth (Joyce) Specketer of Havana and sister, Janet (Dale) Brown of Oakford.
