Dorothy F. Walters, 96, of Mason City passed away Tuesday, November 15, 2016 at the Mason City Area Nursing Home.

She was born November 2, 1920 in Easton, to Ben and Irma (Furrer) Cave. She was the fourth of four children. She married John R. Walters, Sr on September 27, 1941 in Palmyra, Missouri. He preceded her in death on March 23, 1997. She was also preceded in death by her parents and her three siblings, Alice Wieber, Carlos Cave, and Ruby Bortell.

Dorothy is survived by her three children: Sharron Clemons of Springfield, John R. "Richard" Walters, Jr, (Carol) of Mason City, and Ben Walters (Susan) of Boiling Springs, South Carolina; seven grandchildren, nineteen great-grandchildren, and several nieces and nephews.

Dorothy graduated from Easton Community High School in 1938. She was a farm wife and raised three children and later worked for 10 years at Lincoln State School. She was a life-long member of the Easton United Methodist Church. She was a long-time member of the Easton Women's Club where she served as president, and she was a long-time member of the Daughters of the American Revolution.

In her later retirement years Dorothy enjoyed bird watching and reading, and throughout her life she was always spending time with her family. She was living at home until the last four weeks of her life, and she had daily visits from her grandchildren and great-grandchildren which she greatly enjoyed.

A visitation will be held on Saturday, November 19, 2016 at the Easton United

Methodist Church from 9:30 – 11:00 am, and the funeral service will follow at 11:00 with Rev. Al Sample officiating.
