Earl “Weasel” Tucker, 88, of Mason City, Illinois, died Wednesday, November 17, 2010, at the Mason City Area Nursing Home in Mason City. He was born to Vernon and Annie Tucker on September 14, 1922.

Earl is survived by his wife of 62 years, Dorothy J. Tucker, of Mason City, his daughter, Camille (Tom) Massey of Springfield, and his son, Alan (Karen) Tucker.
