Edna Juanita Jones, 93, of Mason City, IL, passed away on Saturday, March 14, 2026. Edna was born on January 15, 1933, in Mason City, IL, to her parents, Edward Herman Hindahl and Margaret Sophia Mary Hindahl (Harries). She married John Lindberg Jones on April 5, 1953, at Christ Lutheran Church in Mason City, IL. They shared 66 wonderful years together.

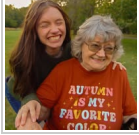
