Edward Burdette Caldwell, 88, of Springfield, formerly of Havana, passed away at St. John's Hospital in Springfield at 6:55 a.m. on Sunday, February 17, 2008. He was born May 11, 1919 in Industry, IL to Bert and Myrtle (Lowderman) Caldwell. He married Freida P. Skaggs on December 2, 1945 in Havana. She preceded him in death on February 27, 2002.
