In the early dawn of a new day, Rev. Edward J. Maddox, 74, arose triumphantly from pain and sickness and went to be with his Lord and Savior Jesus, at 12:28 a.m. on December 23, 2010, while at his home in Springfield, IL.

He was born on September 26, 1936 in St. Louis, MO., the son of James F. and Marie Maddox. He married Nancy Jane Clendenny of Hamburg, IL. on September 11, 1960.

He was preceded in death by his parents, and one sister, Velora Haas.

He is survived by his wife Nancy, sons E.J. (Sheril) Maddox II of Springfield, and Stan (Tammy) Maddox of Columbus, Indiana; grandsons Scott and Greg Maddox; granddaughters Amelia and Alyssa Maddox; brother James P. (Gerry) Maddox of Houston, TX.; an aunt, Henrietta "Bobby" Easton of Worthington, OH; and several cousins, nieces and nephews, grandnieces and

grandnephews.

He graduated from Mascoutah High School in 1954, and McKendree College in Lebanon, IL in 1958. He attended seminaries in Missouri and Washington, D.C. He served as a minister in Illinois, Missouri and Washington, D.C. He was a grade school and high school teacher in Calhoun County, IL., and a social worker for the State of Illinois. He served as pastor of St. Paul's United Church of Christ in Petersburg, IL for 25 years, and retired in January 2005.
