Eileen E. Brown, 87, of Havana, passed away at Mason District Hospital in Havana at 1:20 p.m. on Friday, April 24, 2015. She was born February 10, 1928 in Havana to John and Edith (Steging) Cordes. She married James D. Brown on July 18, 1948 at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Havana. He preceded her in death on July 22, 2007 after 59 years of marriage.

Mrs. Brown is survived by two sons, John (Rusti) Brown of Bradenton, FL, Dr. James (Michelle) Brown of Havana, two daughters, Jeanne (John) Lemkemann of East Peoria, IL and Susan (Paul) Showalter of Havana. Also surviving are fourteen grandchildren and fifteen great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents and husband.
