Eldon Duane Wahlfeld, 89, of Manito, passed away at 9:09 a.m. on Friday, August 8, 2025 at Arcadia Care Nursing Home in Havana. 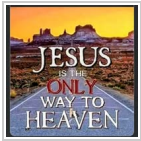
