



## Emma Hubbartt

August 20, 1922 - October 13, 2021

Emma Hubbartt passed away on October 13, 2021, at the age of 99, after bravely facing congestive heart failure for many weeks. Born on August 20, 1922 in Jacksonville, IL, she attended school in Jacksonville and Petersburg, IL, then completed elementary teachers' training in Normal, IL. She married Army Airforce cadet, Gene Hubbartt (now deceased), in Bennetsville, SC during WWII.
