Eugene L. Hackman, 94, of Havana, passed away at his home in Havana, IL at 1:48 p.m. on Friday, October 12, 2012. He was born February 27, 1918 in Havana to Arnold and Elsie (Bortell) Hackman. He married Julia Virginia Hickman on September 7, 1940 in Kahoka, MO.

Mr. Hackman is survived by one son, Arnold E. Hackman of the Phillipines, and is also survived by four grandchildren, eleven great grandchildren and eight great great grandchildren.
