Evalena Alvena Dierker, 94, of Manito, passed away at 7:20 p.m., on Sunday, May 30, 2021. She was born October 22, 1926, in Havana, Illinois, to George and Alma (Kreiling) Glick. She married Frederick W. Dierker at St. Paul's Lutheran Church, in Havana, on April 1949. He preceded her in death on September, 13, 1992.

Mrs. Dierker is survived by two daughters: Susan M.
