January 14, 1932 - May 1, 2014

Everett Cade, 82, of Petersburg, went to be with his Savior Thursday, May 1, 2014 at 4:00 pm. He was born January 14, 1932 the son of Thomas R. and Alice B. (Puff) Cade in Bradford, IL. He married Carlene Swearingen in Clarksville, MO on January 27, 1951.

Everett is survived by his wife of 63 years, Carlene; daughter, Nancy (Tony) Robbins of Lincoln; sons, Everett (Sara) Cade Jr. of Petersburg and Tom (Jackie) Cade of Broadwell and daughter, Chery (Gragg) Stacy of Petersburg. He is also survived by 13 grandchildren and 15 great grandchildren.
