Fannie Lou Bertram, 87, of Springfield, formerly of Middletown, Illinois, passed away at Memorial Medical Center, in Springfield, at 10:43 p.m., on Tuesday, February 8, 2022. She was born February 20, 1935, in Holly Hill, South Carolina, to James Kistler and Julia Isabelle (Crosby) Blocker. She married Alvin R. 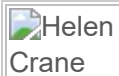


