Floyd John Hagney, 87, of Havana passed away at 5:15 p.m. on Tuesday, May 11, 2021 at Mason District Hospital. He was born on April 8, 1934 in Fulton, Illinois to Harry and Josephine (Miller) Hagney. He married Mae Squires in Havana on December 5, 1981.
