Floyd Jean Koke, 88, of Kilbourne, passed away at 7:30 a.m. on Saturday, November 10, 2018 at The Lodge at Manito. He was born February 5, 1930 in Kilbourne, IL, to John and Emma (Staging) Koke. He married Georgia Phyllis Adlington on August 23, 1951 in Springfield, IL. She preceded him in death on May 23, 2016.
