Gene Raymond Harris, 68, of Havana, passed away at 10:20 a.m. on Sunday, September 1, 2013 at Havana Health Care. He was born October 23, 1944 in Mattoon, IL at home to William O. and Elizabeth Edna (Mullins) Harris. He married Jane L. Frost on July 22, 1967 in Mattoon.

Mr. Harris is survived by his wife, Jane, daughter, Melanie (Dr. Renold) Bleem, two grandchildren, Samuel and McKenna Bleem, all of Havana, two brothers, Tony (Lois) Harris of Gays, IL, Carl (Frances) Harris of Charleston, IL, two sisters, Lola (Bob) Craig and Lillie Gaston, both of Mattoon. Gene joined the US Marine Corps at age 17 and served from 1962 until 1966, also serving in the Vietnam War. He worked as a

Journeyman Ironworker with Local #112 in Peoria, retiring after over 40 years.

A celebration of life will be held at the Havana Church of Christ at Noon on Saturday, September 7, 2013 with visitation two hours prior to the services. Rev. Bill Boyce will officiate.
