Manito, IL - George Schneider, Jr, 81 of Manito passed away at 11:00 pm Friday, May, 2, 2008 at Methodist Medical Center in Peoria. He was born August 22, 1926 in Chicago to George and Betty Holland Schneider, Sr. He married Fern S. Starnes Long Dec. 23, 1992 in Havana and she survives.
