George Ann Stevens, 79, of Petersburg, Illinois, passed away on Sunday, December 20, 2020, at Sunny Acres Nursing Home in Petersburg.

She was born on April 14, 1941 in Springfield, Illinois, the daughter of George and Marjorie (Jockisch) Henderson. She married Ronald Stevens on June 12, 1960.
