Gladys Samuel Hudspeth died Sunday, January 7, 2007 at 11:10 am at Menard Convalescent Center . She was born September 23, 1910, the daughter of Andrew J. and Sallie Ann Campbell Samuel. She married Richard P. Hudspeth April 6, 1930 in Jacksonville , IL ; he preceded her in death May 14, 1998.

She was a member of First Christian Church, Petersburg Woman's Club, and both she and her husband were active for many years at the Shambole Golf Club.

They owned and operated the Hudspeth Implement and Feed Store until their retirement in 1968.

Gladys served as secretary and bookkeeper for Campbell's Hatcheries and worked 10 years at Menard County Mutual Fire Insurance Company as Office Secretary.

Her church and church family were very important to her and she served in many ways, namely as organist, Sunday school teacher, secretary, historian, and clerk.

She was a graduate of Chandlerville High School and Browns Business College in Jacksonville . She trained to be a court reporter as a steno typist.

She is survived by her son, Samuel R. (wife Peggy) Hudspeth of Tucson, Arizona; one grandson, Gregory (Sharon) Hudspeth of Hampden, Maine ; two great granddaughters, Alex and Evon Hudspeth of Hampden , Maine ; and several nieces and nephews.
