



## Glenn R. Fanter

January 13, 1937 - June 3, 2023

Glenn Robert Fanter, 86, of Kilbourne passed away on Saturday, June 3, 2023 at Mason City Area Nursing Home. He was born on January 13, 1937 in Mason County, Illinois to Louis J. and Berna K. (Kastendick) Fanter. He married Barbara E. Hutson on January 19, 1959 in Ceres, California.

Glenn is survived by his wife, Barbara Fanter, of Kilbourne; children, Timothy G. (Amy) Fanter of Kilbourne, Judy (Tony) Miller of Easton, Doris (Daryle) Attebery of Easton, and Wendy (Kevin) Martin of The Colony, Texas; 10 grandchildren; 24 great-grandchildren; and siblings, Jean Clink of Indianapolis, Wayne (Pat) Fanter of Springfield, Wanda (Len) Beck of Springfield, and Marilyn (Don) Blakeley of Kilbourne. Glenn was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church in Bath. After graduating from high school, he served in the Navy as an aviation mechanic and then returned home to become a farmer. He was a Master Farmer with the Illinois State FFA, past president of the Bath-Lynchburg Association of Alumni, and was President of the Easton School Board for 8 years. Glenn was also a Master Gardener. He ran the Junior Master Gardener program through 4-H, along with the Bee Club. He was a member of the Farm Bureau and the Central Illinois Irrigated Growers Association. He was a mentor at the New Central Elementary School for 8 years and also at Spoon River College.
