Gordon Paul Reedy, 81, of Havana, passed away at OSF-St. Francis Medical Center, in Peoria, at 11:51 p.m. on Monday, March 25, 2019. He was born November 22, 1937, in Table Grove, Illinois, to Wayne Cecil and Florence Arlene (Workman) Reedy. He married Sandra Jo Logan in Macomb, IL on June 7, 1969.

Mr. Reedy is survived by one daughter: Teresa (Matt) Kline, of Havana; grandchildren: Anthony (Whitney) Kline of Havana and Amanda Kline of Havana; great-grandchildren: Aidan Kline and Emma Jane Kline and special friends Bryan and Terri Mapes. 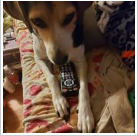
