Gussie Lucille Craggs, 98, of Havana, passed away at 5:45 p.m. on Friday, August 22, 2008 at Em's Haven of Rest in Havana. She was born December 26, 1909 in Sangamon Co., IL to John Quincy and Mattie (Hinds) Foster. She married Alva Craggs in Manito on June 10, 1937. He preceded her in death in April 1965.

Mrs. Craggs is survived by two daughters: Camilla Masten of Hazelwood, MO and Rebecca (Glen) Vanderveen of Havana; two grandsons: Tony (Ana) Masten and John (Brandi) Masten and four great-grandchildren: Natalie, Paige, Darci and Kent Masten.
